This Afternoon

Showers and possibly a thunderstorm. High near 55. Southeast wind 10 to 15 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New rainfall amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.

Tonight

Showers and thunderstorms before 4am, then a slight chance of showers. Low around 35. Breezy, with a south/southwest wind 10 to 20 mph becoming northwest after midnight. Winds could gust as high as 30 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New rainfall amounts between a quarter and half of an inch possible.

Friday

Mostly cloudy, with a temperature falling to around 35 by 9am. Breezy, with a north/northwest wind 20 to 25 mph, with gusts as high as 35 mph.

Friday Night

Partly cloudy, with a low around 20. North northeast wind around 10 mph, with gusts as high as 15 mph.

SECTION 4 – EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS

Declarations of Emergency/Disaster

- On March 13, 2020, the President declared a National Emergency Declaration for all States.
- On March 9, 2020, the Governor declared all counties in the State of Illinois a Disaster Area.

SECTION 5 – PUBLIC INFORMATION

- All public information is being vetted through Kyle Auman at Ogle County Public Health.
Municipalities / Agencies are encouraged to link up their public information regarding this event.
- On orders of the Governor
 - All schools are closed until March 30, 2020.
 - As of 16 Mar 2020 all restaurants are closed to dining. They may remain open for takeout and delivery operations.
 - As of 16 March 2020 all bars and taverns will close.
- Ogle and Lee Counties have recommended that all public gathering over 25 people be cancelled or postponed until further notice.
- Other jurisdictions are following the CDC recommendations of gatherings over 50.
- ***PER IDPH, Social distancing measures everyone can take include:***
 - ***Staying home as much as possible***
 - ***If gatherings are necessary, limiting the number of people to 10***
 - ***Calling to check on family, neighbors, and older adults instead of visiting •
Checking with your provider about telehealth options***
